I am writing to express my strong support for the city of Flint's Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction (LBPHR) grant program application.

There is no safe level of lead exposure for children. Flint, Michigan, has thousands of homes that were built before 1979, homes that are a higher risk to have lead-based paint. Every step must be taken to reduce children's exposure to lead in Flint, especially considering the ongoing recovery from the Flint water crisis. This grant would allow the city of Flint to further invest their lead remediation programming and address paint hazards in Flint homes. This grant would also train dozens of Flint residents to be certified in lead remediation.

I strongly support the city of Flint's Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction (LBPHR) grant program application, and I hope you will look favorably upon their proposal to the extent federal law and agency regulations apply.
